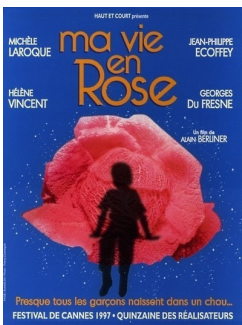


Le Petit Prince (2015)
